River flow leaving Cowichan Lake currently at 31 cms and has peaked – will slowly decline as lake level continues to drop.

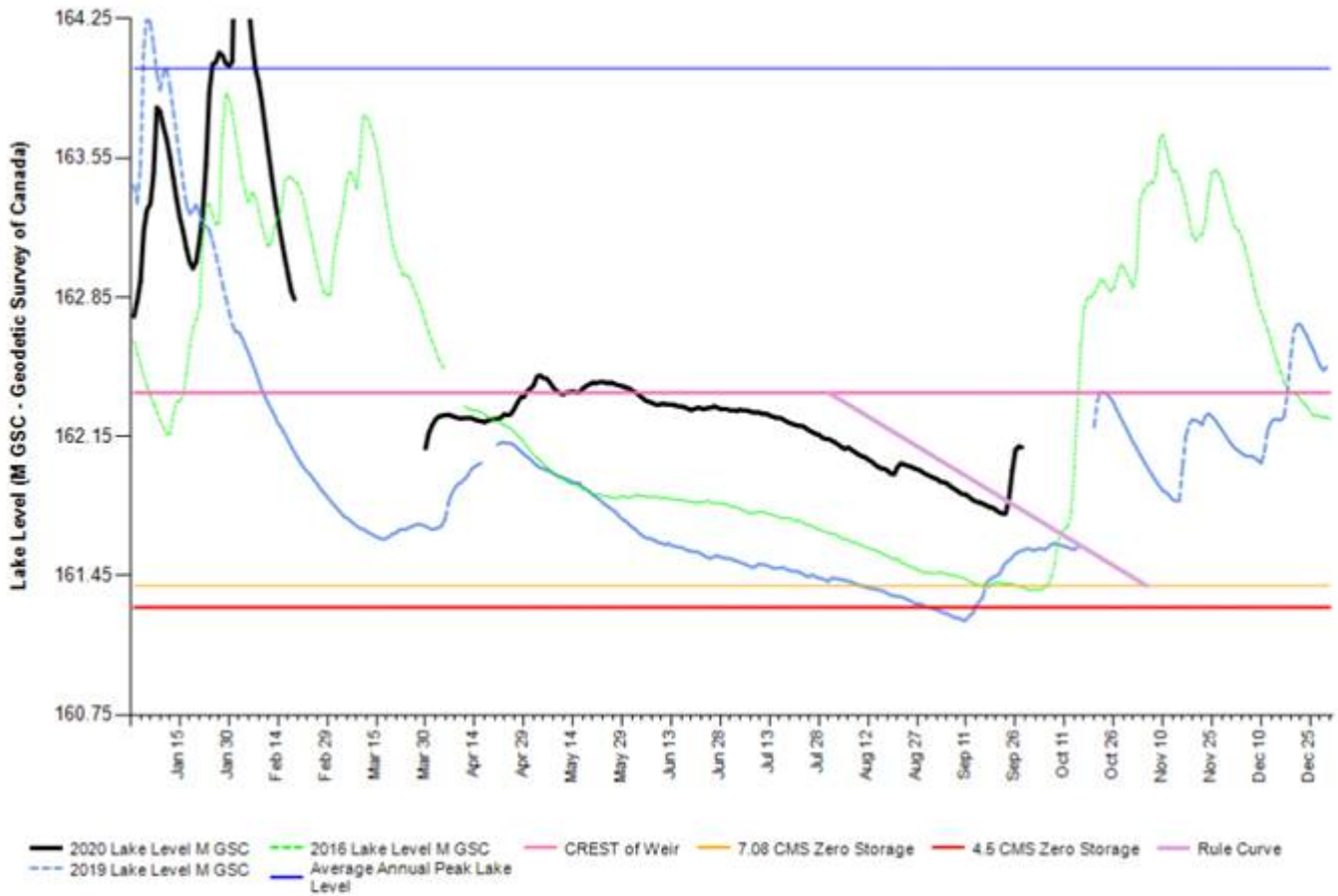
River flow in Duncan is at 39 cms and very slowly trending down as well.

The flow in Duncan will decline faster than flow from lake given the tributaries to Cowichan River will lose flow quickly in dry weather.

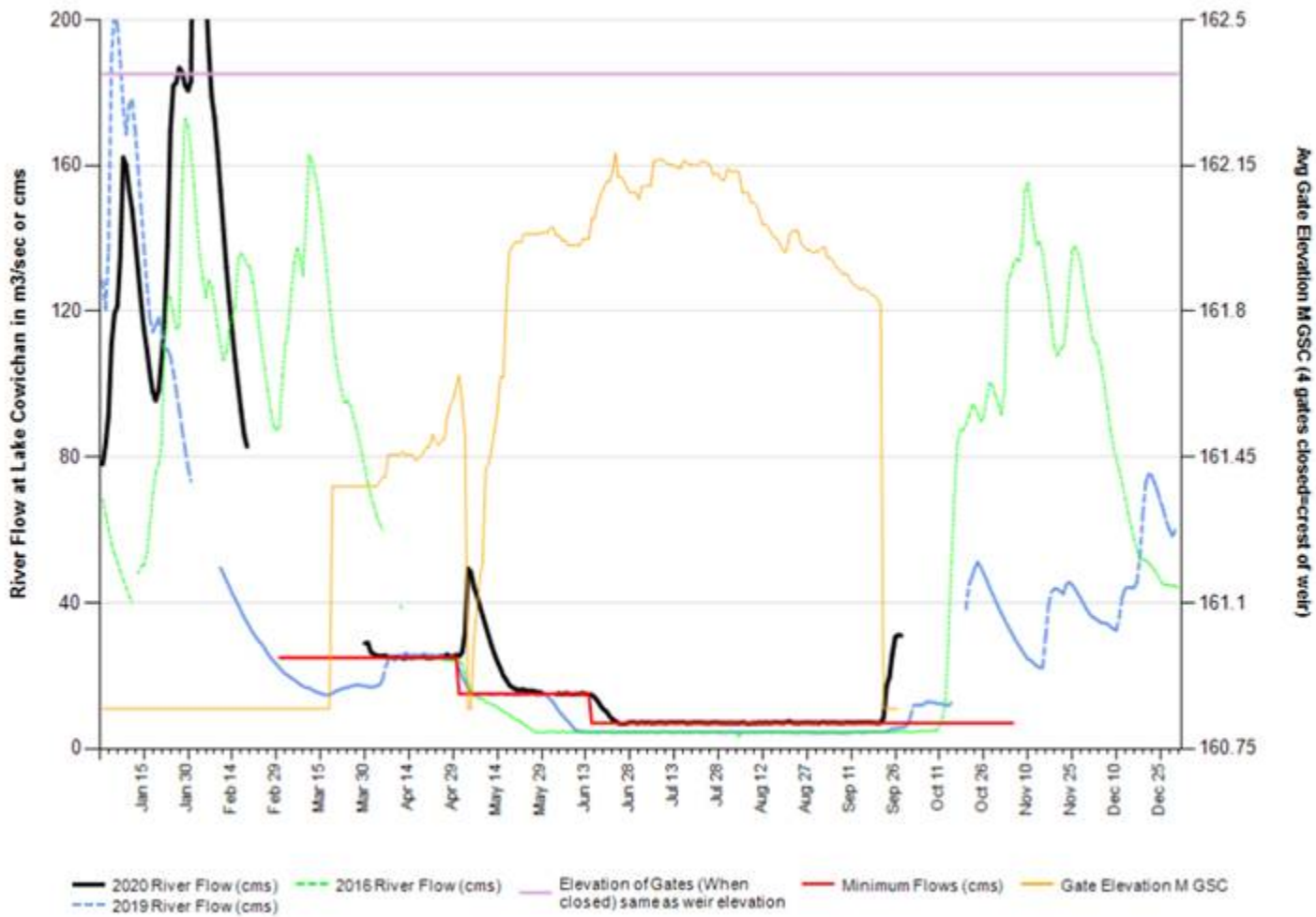
The weather prediction shows no rainfall in coming 7 days and that will result in river flows slowly declining until rainfall returns.
