	<input type="checkbox"/> SUBSTITUTE: Change the work process.
	<input type="checkbox"/> ENGINEER: Design the worksite, equipment, process to minimize or contain the hazard. Exp. Installed barriers to protect workers?
	<input type="checkbox"/> ADMINISTRATIVE: Limit the workers exposure to the hazard through safe work procedures/plans
	<input type="checkbox"/> PPE: Used as a last resort to protect workers from exposure to a hazard.
