

FIBRE PROCUREMENT POLICY

Meadow Lake Mechanical Pulp Inc. is committed to environmentally sound business practices. We believe that our commitment to the environment starts with the sustainable procurement and use of wood fibre in our manufacturing process.

We provide assurance to our customers that we are using procedures to facilitate the transfer of responsibly managed wood fibre through the supply chain.

We monitor our sources to ensure that the wood fibre is not procured from:

- Illegally harvested wood;
- Wood harvested in violation of traditional and human rights;
- Wood harvested from forests in which high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
- Wood harvested from forests converted to plantations or non-forest use;
- Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted;
- Wood from suppliers who are in violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions.

We maintain a Chain of Custody Management System, which includes objectives and controls for continual monitoring and improvement of our performance, and we communicate our records to all interested parties.

Our approach to forest management, use, and renewal ensures that all forest attributes will be conserved for future generations.
