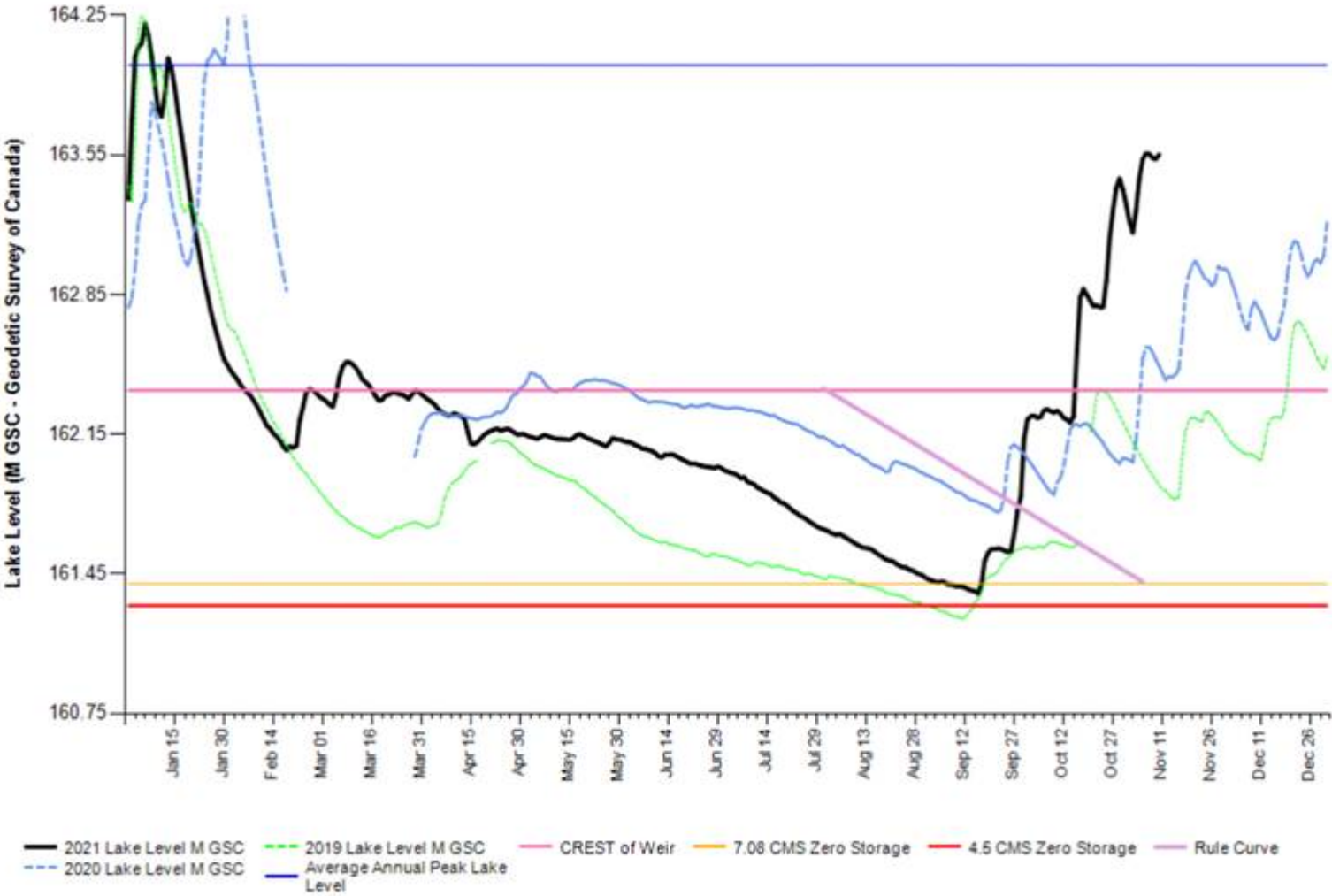
Good day everyone,

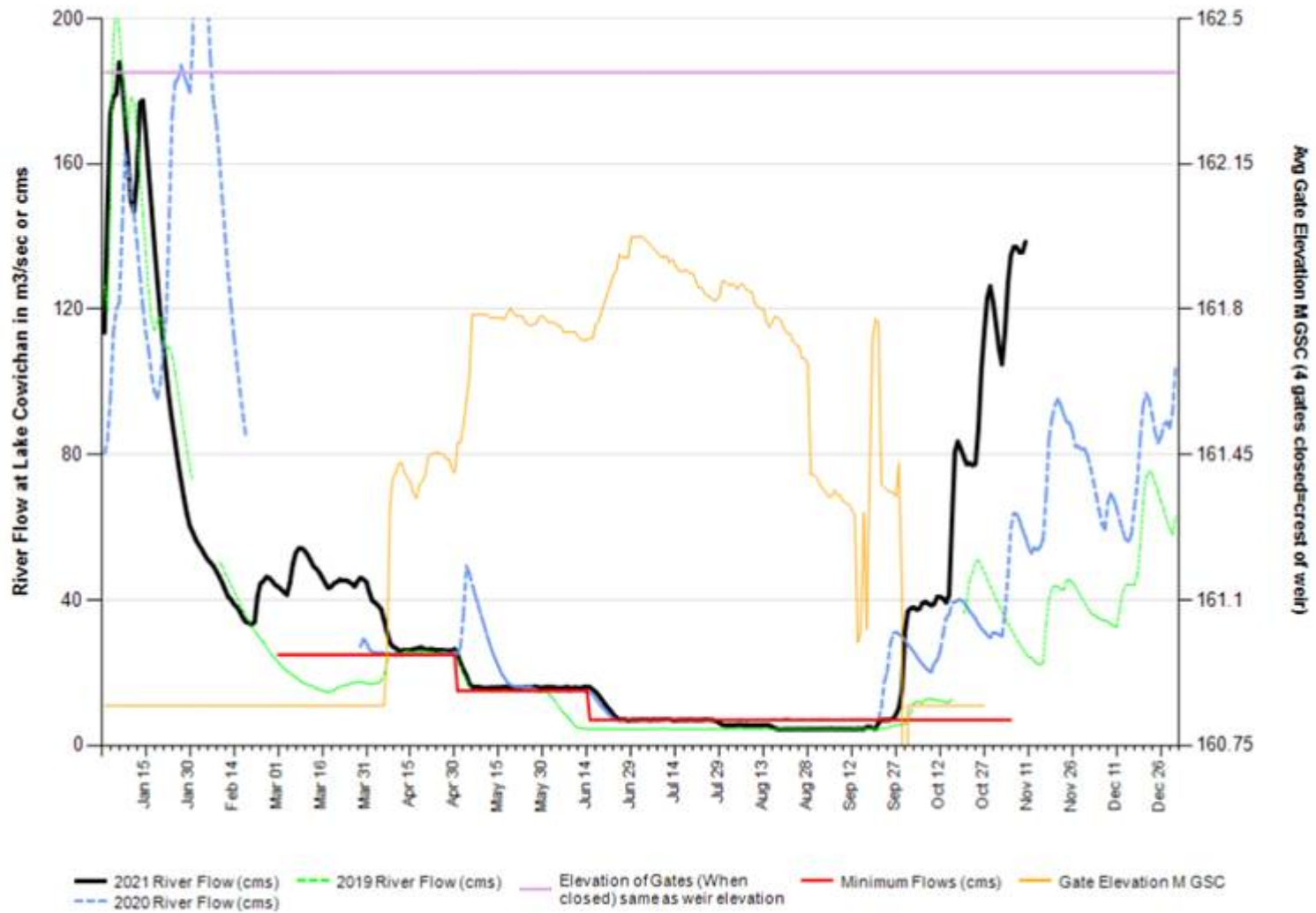

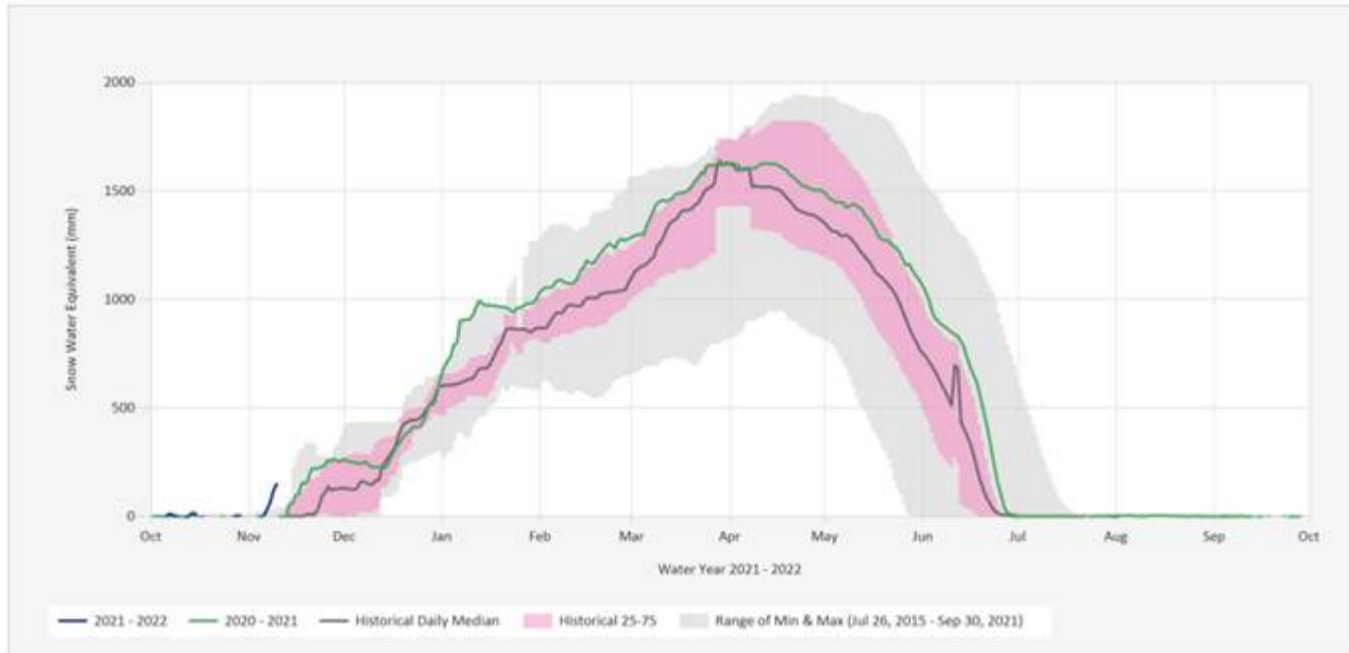
2021 Cowichan Lake Level - 2021 (Black) & 2020 (Blue) & 2019 (Green)

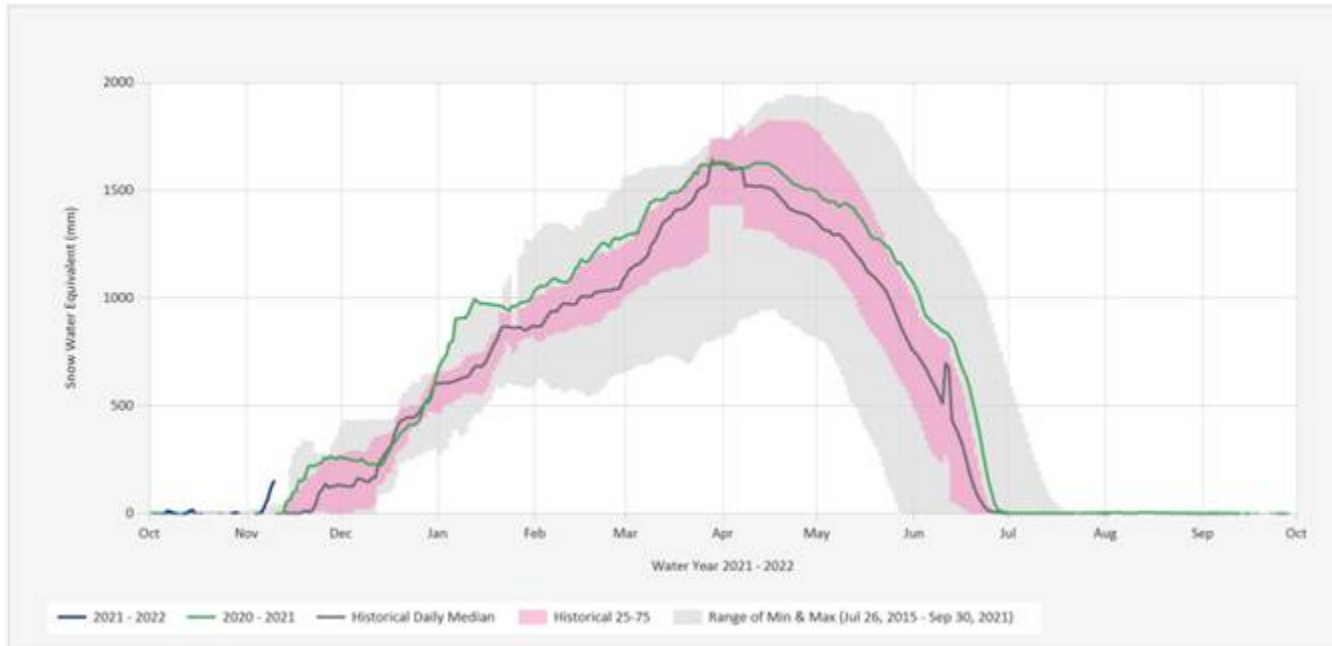


2021 Cowichan River Flow - 2021 (Black) & 2020 (Blue) & 2019 (Green)
