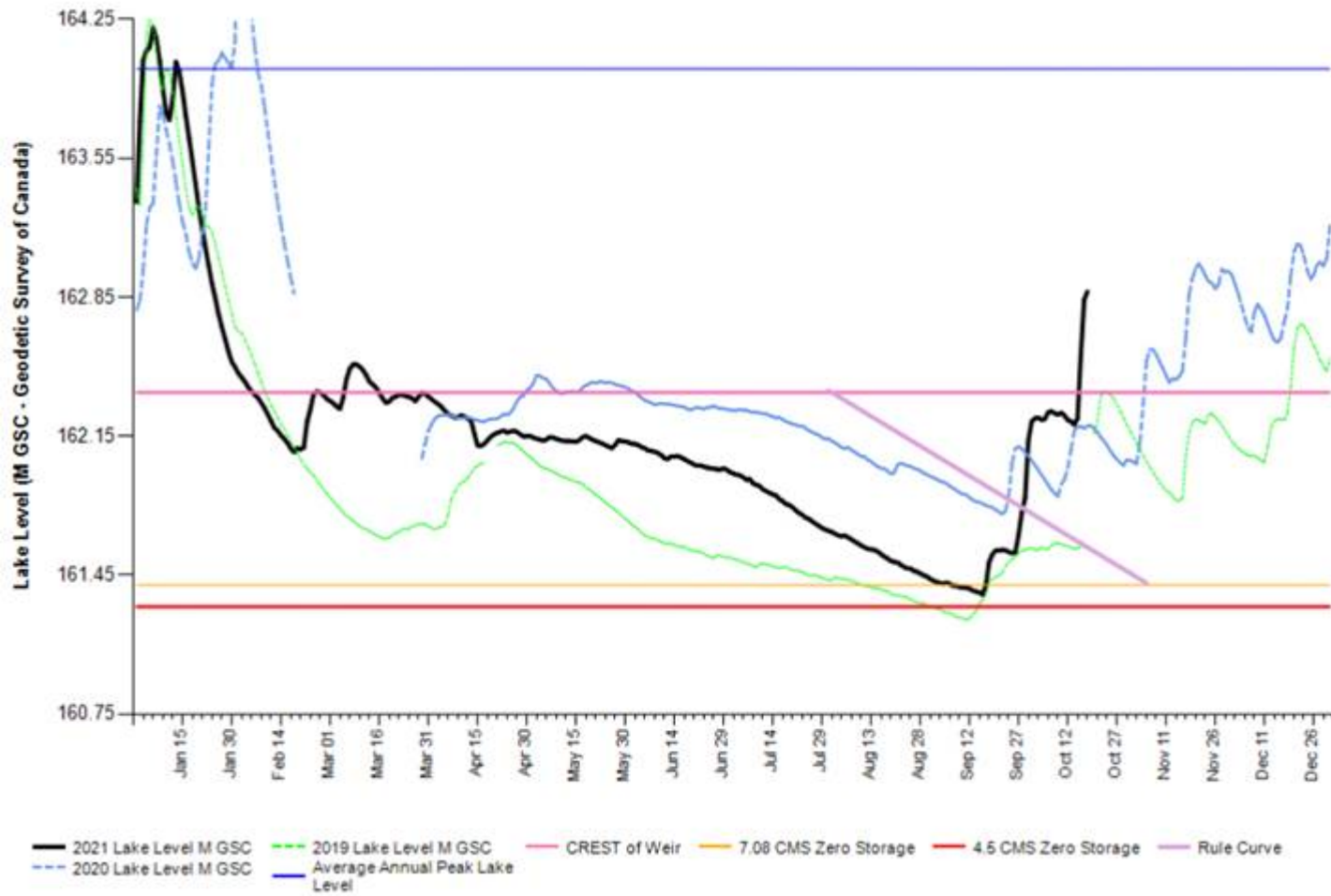
Good day everyone,

Another river system has passed over us this past weekend and at this time of year, substantial rainfall can arrive and did arrive. Lake level has peaked to almost 163 M GSC and with that, a river flow of just over 80 cubic meters per second leaving the lake. The weir was taken off control on September 30th and then on October 12th the weir was winterized.

In the coming months of wet weather I will provide less frequent updates and more importantly, will begin preparing for what could be another challenging water year, 2022, which is just a few months away.
