Conditions continue to be concerning with lack of snow pack accumulation on west coast.



Fortunately, at this time, the lake level is well above full supply and at the same lake level as last year on this day.


If weather stays on dry side in coming weeks, lake level will be at full supply on about Feb 24th, like it was in 2023.




2024 Cowichan Lake Level - 2024 (Black) & 2023 (Blue) & 2022 (Green)
