Conditions remain very good in watershed.

Lake level is now at 88% full and enough water to allow the flow to be sustained at 7.1 cms through to September.

There was a flow calibration of the gauge in river at town of Lake Cowichan and that shifted the flow a bit.

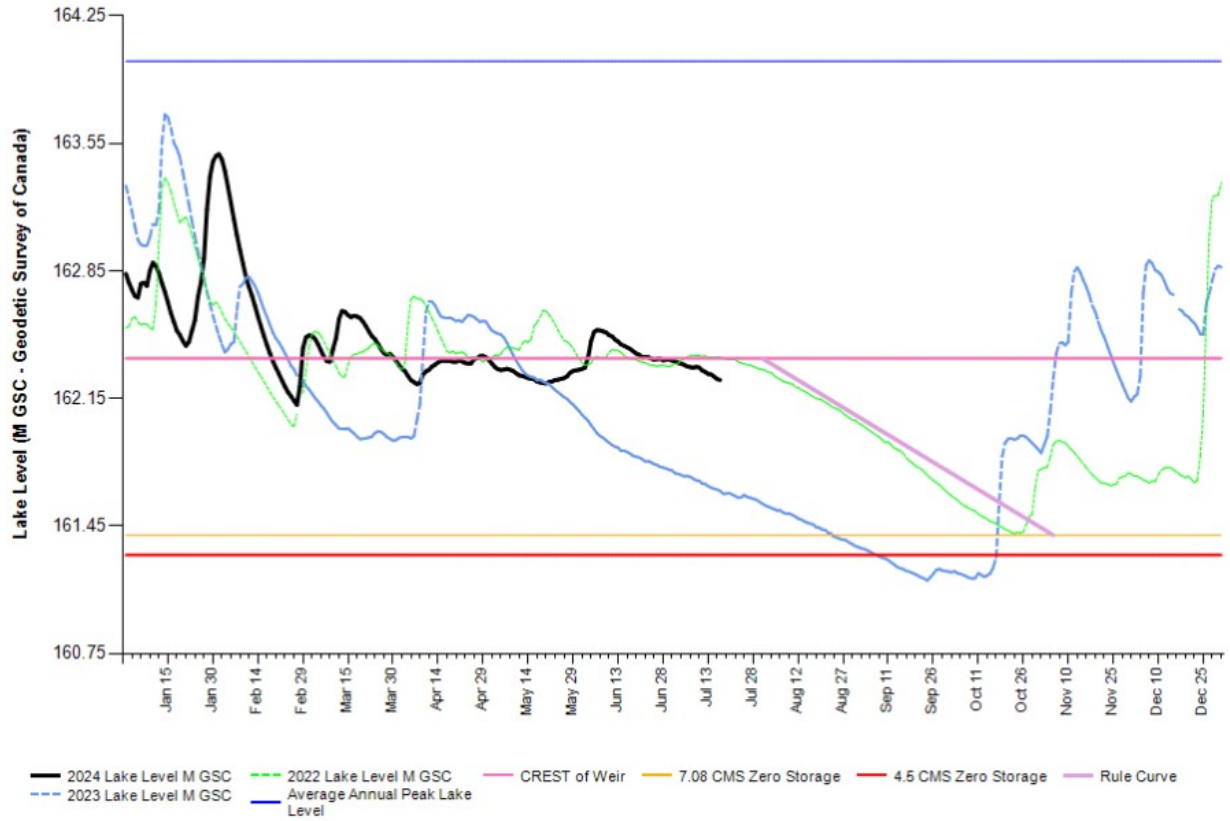

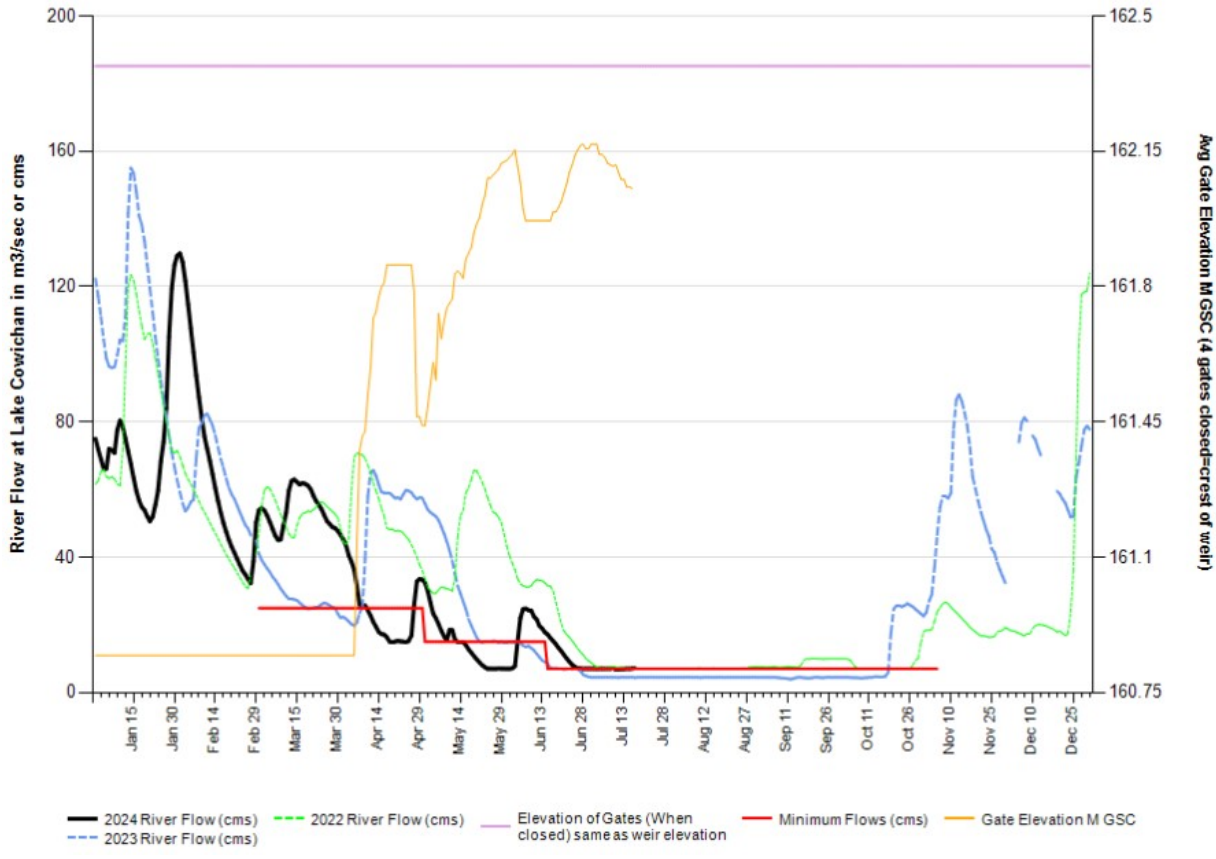
