

SKOOKUMCHUCK MILL

Located on the western edge of the Canadian Rocky Mountains in the East Kootenay region of British Columbia, Skookumchuck Pulp is a vital employer to the area. Commissioned in 1968, Skookumchuck Pulp has seen substantial modernization work making the mill one of Paper Excellence's most sophisticated facilities. Skookumchuck is a word derived from the local First Nations language meaning "strong water" and it is the name of the creek that supplies the mill with water.
