Commissioned in 1992, Meadow Lake Mechanical Pulp's purchase by Paper Excellence in 2007 marked Paper Excellence's entry into the Canadian pulp and paper market.

The Paper Excellence Meadow Lake Mill is a leading producer of high quality Bleached Chemi Thermal Mechanical Pulp (BCTMP). This pulp is used by customers primarily in Asia to make a wide variety of products from tissue and paper towels to food and board packaging.

#### **FACILITIES AND PRODUCTION CAPACITY**

- 405,000 tonnes of Bleached Chemi Thermal Mechanical Pulp (BCTMP) annually
- A primary producer of biomass suitable as feedstock for green energy production
- A totally chlorine-free mill, it was the first in the world not to discharge any effluent or waste water into any nearby creek, river, stream or lake
